

# How To Register To Vote

Any United States Citizen 18 years old by December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year that you file a form to Register To Vote has the right to and is eligible to vote for public office and participate in the voting process in their home state that they reside in. Election Day is always the first Tuesday following the first Monday in November.

Please check with your home state for Qualifications to Register to Vote, How and Where to Register To Vote (Registration Deadlines), Absentee Voting and Military and Overseas Voting, How to make Changes to Your Registration- Change of Name/ or Address or how to make a Change of Party Enrollment.

Check with your home state also for information regarding Special, Primary or General Elections.
